WBCPCR in collaboration with KEERTIKA, an organisation working on rights and empowerment of women and children has conducted a study titled: Towards Educating the Life of a Child as a Citizen & Revisiting the Education System at School Levels: Findings from West Bengal.

Main objectives of this collaborative study of WBCPCR and KEERTIKA:

- i. Number of critical areas of teaching methods that need to be reviewed in the light of changing socio economic perspectives
- ii. Role of other professionals (alongwith teachers) like Psychologists, MSWs, Human Rights Experts, Sociologists, Doctors to work as a team in preparing students as worthy citizen of country
- iii. Identification of vocational/technical skills among students at early age to charter a clear path for his/her future career
- iv. Schools as institution to act as nurturing and grooming future citizen

Outcome of this meeting will lead the study to derive a set of recommendations and prioritize the strategies to address the issue.
