Child Friendly Corner at Kolkata International Book Fair 2020: A Report 29th January, 2020- 9th February, 2020, Central Park, Saltlake



Inauguration

It was 29th January, 2020, Wednesday. It was raining cats & dogs since morning and dark clouds were hovering around the sky. But in the afternoon, overcoming all the threatening forecasts, the Child Friendly Corner of WBCPCR was inaugurated by Dr. Shashi Panja, the Hon'ble MOS (IC), Department of Women & Child Development and Social Welfare, Government of West Bengal. Sri Chiranjit Chakraborty, renowned actor of Bengali cinema and Sri Surajit Chatterjee, famous music star were also among the special guests.



In her brief note, Dr. Shashi Panja said, "This is the third year WBCPCR is participating in the Kolkata International Bookfair. Children who will visit the book fair and this child friendly corner will get to know about their Rights and all the good jobs done by the government for them".

Smt. Ananya Chakraborti, the Hon'ble Chairperson of WBCPCR said, "Our Commission is relentlessly working towards protecting of child rights. We organize lots of awareness building programmes throughout the year. Participation in the book fair with this child friendly corner is also part of them."

Sri Chiranjit Chakraborty was of the opinion that booklets published by the Commission on various child rights issues such as cyber safety, child marriage, POCSO and Hullor, the children's magazine of WBCPCR are very useful in enhancing awareness among children about their rights.

Sri Surajit Chatterjee also appreciated the role of the Commission in protecting child rights of the state.

It was originally published by the *National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR)*. WBCPCR has translated this handbook from English to Bengali for training and skill development of staff of Child Care Institutions (CCIs).

WBCPCR's planning for the Book Fair started six months back with sending the application letter to the Publishers & Booksellers Guild for having a stall at the 44th Kolkata International Book Fair in 2020. Internal meetings were convened a number of times so that all aspects including budget, interior and exterior design of the stall, participation, strategy of awareness building campaign on child rights issues, sale & distribution of Hullor were to be looked into properly. On January, 2020, a rectangular space of 600 square feet was allotted by the guild committee to the Commission at the Central Park Mela Ground, Saltlake and Child Friendly Corner was created there by the Commission with the focal theme Hansel and Gretel, one of the most popular children's classics of Germany.
